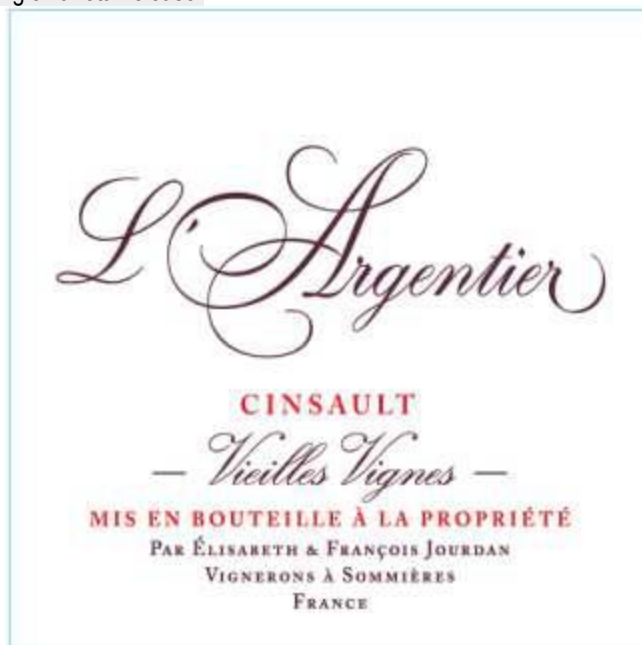


## Chateau L'Argentier Cinsault 2013 Languedoc-Rousillon, France

Located in *Sommières*, between Nimes and Montpellier, Chateau L'Argentier has been owned and operated by the Jourdan family since 1937. Although Cinsault is usually blended, Chateau L'Argentier Cinsault is stunning example of a single varietal release.



Appellation: PAYS D'HÉRAULT – indication géographique protégée.

Grapes: 100% Cinsault.

Age of the vines: Vineyard planted in 1969.

Yields: 35 hl/ hectare.

Winemaking: Fermentation in concrete vats, temperature control, daily pumping over the must, maceration.

Ageing: 12 months in concrete vats.

A lively nose of blackcurrant, Morello cherry, dried herbs and spice leads to a medium-bodied, fruit-forward palate marked by velvety tannins and moderate acidity. A hint of vanilla lingers through the finish.
