



Ress J. Bäumer Rhein Riesling

The Joachim Bäumer (J. Bäumer) was born in the Rheingau located on the Rhine River, in the 1950s and acquired by the Ress family in 1957 as an extension of their proprietary Rheingau property. The Rheingau spans about 50km from end to end and the greater part of the vineyards are situated along the Rhine River.

The noble Riesling grape is the finest white grape in the world and J. Bäumer Riesling is an outstanding example of why we love this grape varietal. It offers vibrant aromatics, purity and freshness. Floral, apple, honey and melon aromas give this wine a very pleasant nose. The palate is slightly sweet, offering ripe apple, peach, melon and mango flavors with good acidity and a pleasant mouth feel. This zippy Riesling bursts with a mix of green apple, white peach, freshly picked pear and apricot with a perfume of white blossoms. The balance of fruit, sweetness and refreshing acidity together with mineral notes typifying this Riesling. It finishes with lingering ripe peach and apple flavors. It is pure deliciousness.
