**Region:** Castilla y León

**Vineyard of origin:** The Vineyards are situated on the hillsides oriented south, with soil and gravel bottom clay.

**Variety:** 100% Tempranillo

**Winemaking:** Temperature-controlled less than 28 sessions, macerations 15 days.

**Breeding:** Aged for 180 days in oak barrels.

**Color:** Attractive deep red cherry

**Nose:** Emphasize ripe red fruit, with soft tones of fine wood and toast.

**Taste:** It is intense, pleasant and very well balanced, where the wood does not detract from prominence to the fruit.

Serving temperature: 16 °
